**APPEAL AGAINST PENALTIES FOR INCORRECT OR DELAYED
SUBMISSION OF PAYE RETURNS**

The good news – at last after several months, a letter from our friends in the HMRC confirming that they have decided to uphold our appeal and discharge the PAYE penalty notice in full !
